



WANT TO DO MORE?

Red Tent Fund is the first national Jewish direct service abortion fund, providing grants directly to independent abortion clinics so they can fund their patients' care. If you've already made a gift and want to do more, you're in the right place!

Volunteers play a vital role in advancing Red Tent Fund's mission to ensure people can access abortion care when they need it. While we do not work directly with patients, volunteers help grow awareness, build community support, and mobilize resources that fund essential care, and in some cases, help us with administrative tasks that support our back office.

Whether you have a few hours or want to take on a larger role, your involvement helps turn compassion into meaningful impact. By sharing our story, hosting conversations, and helping build community support, volunteers expand awareness and make it possible for more patients to receive direct financial assistance for abortion care.





Here are some ways to get involved:

- **Tell your people about us.** The single most powerful thing you can do is talk about Red Tent Fund in your networks. We make it easy with ready-to-send email templates and collateral to share with friends, family, and community members. Check our website for templates!
- **Bring us into your congregation.** Red Tent Fund partners with synagogues and Jewish communities across the country to build a network of support for abortion access. If your community is interested in becoming a partner, please contact bryce@redtentfund.org.
- **Stock the client pantry.** Many abortion clinics maintain a pantry of essential supplies for patients. Check with your local clinic about their needs. You can often shop from their wish list or donate items you already have at home.
- **Become a volunteer clinic escort.** Clinic escorts provide a calm, supportive presence for patients arriving at clinics. Ask a local clinic to learn more.
- **Host a care package packing party.** Gather your friends, your book club, your havurah and spend a few hours assembling post-abortion care packages for patients. Your local clinic can tell you what patients want in the kits or search "post abortion care kits" online.
- **Host your own fundraiser.** Want to raise money for Red Tent Fund in your community? We have toolkits and templates you can use to create the right event for you and your network. Email bryce@redtentfund.org.
- **Talk to young people about abortion.** Normalize and destigmatize abortion. The conversations you have in your own family and community matter more than you think.
- **Know what's happening in your state.** Abortion policy is changing rapidly, and staying informed is one of the most important things you can do. Learn what laws and ballot measures are active or upcoming in your state, share accurate information with the people around you, and consider connecting with local organizations doing policy education work.
- **Join a committee.** The Red Tent Fund Board of Directors lead the following committees: Regional Engagement, Development, and Communications. Sit on a committee and offer expertise, ideas, and task completion help in each area. Committees meet monthly with "homework" between meetings. Email bryce@redtentfund.org.
